MAUI COMIC CON COSPLAY RULES AND REGULATIONS:

- 1.) Please make sure your costume covers all of your private areas. This is a family-friendly competition. If your costume is deemed inappropriate by the Maui Comic Con Judges, you will be asked to leave the competition. If you are worried about adhering to this rule, email a picture of the costume in advance.
- 2.) Tier 1 Costumes (ages 3-12) must be 30% made. Tier 2 Costumes (13 and up) must be 60% made.
- 3.) Wings, large props, or large costumes are fine, but if your costume is over 8 feet tall, or 4 feet wide you may not fit through the doors. If possible, make wings and other parts that make your costume de- teachable.
- 4.) Please be sure to have a handler with you if you have trouble walking. We have no limit on the size of costumes or props, but ask that you be safe and aware while on stage. You will be responsible for ALL damage that may occur to the Venue or other contestants.
- 5.) Everything that comes with you on stage **MUST** come back off with you.
- 6.) To ensure the safety of all other participants, please do not spread confetti, liquid, messy substances, glitter, or anything that can- not be picked up quickly and easily.
- 7.) No dangerous materials including but not limited to open flames, candles, sparklers, or fireworks are permitted.
- 8.) No projectile weapons are permitted including but not limited to real firearms, pellet/BB guns, paint- ball guns, air guns, water guns, cap guns, dart guns, bows or crossbows. No live steel (edged metal weapons) will be permitted. Replica weapons must be made of a non- metal, non- sharp material.
- 9.) All weapons must be pre-checked (At weapon check location) before going on stage. **No functional weapons are allowed at Maui Comic Con.** Simulated or costume weapons are allowed as a part of your costume, subject to prior approval by security and compliance with the following:
 - All costume weapons must be inspected at the REGISTRATION/CHECK IN COUNTERS.
 - All costume weapons must conform to state and federal law.
 - Projectile costume weapons must be rendered inoperable.
 - Functional (real) arrows must have their tips removed and be bundled and zip tied to a quiver
 - Costume swords must be tied to your costume in such a way that they can't be drawn.
 - Security will escort you to the security station for inspection if your costume weapon is not tagged.
 - Prop weapons must be submitted to "Weapons Check" for Peace Bonding. We may revoke Peace Bonding at any time in our sole discretion.
 - If a prop weapon is, or was, at any time capable of firing anything, it must be rendered permanently inoperable in order to qualify for Peace Bonding. You can do this by, for example, permanently plugging the barrel with glue, caulk, or any non-removable substance. You must be able to prove that the gun is permanently decommissioned upon inspection. Bring tools if necessary.

If you do not want to have your costume weapons inspected or tagged, or if you are not willing to comply with these policies, please do not bring your costume weapons to Maui Comic Con.
